

What is Peace Challenge 2010?

- An annual competition for young people, aged 15-18 (or Year 10 and above), run by Pax Christi UK
- A great way for young people to get their voice heard, learn new skills and work together to make a positive difference
- A chance for the winning team to join others from across Europe in the Peace House in Florence, 9 -11 April and for two more teams to present their DVDs at the Peace History Conference on 16 April at the Imperial War Museum, London

What makes a peace hero or heroine? There are many official peace awards such as the Nobel Peace Prize, the Right Livelihood Award, the Pax Christi International Peace Award and more. What would **you** choose to recognise or value in a peacemaker? How would **you** tell their story?

How to enter

Step 1

Your first challenge is to create a list of your **own criteria** and then apply this to a peace hero or heroine:

- Someone from the past or a person in today's world who has inspired you because of their work for peace and justice.
- Someone who has worked in the international scene or someone who has worked at local or community level... maybe someone in your own school!

You could do this with a youth or confirmation group, an impact group, at school or simply as a group of friends.

Step 2

Whatever action you decide to take, in a team of four, make a short presentation video or power-point (5 minutes max) and send it on a CD along with your criteria list and the entry form on the back of this leaflet to

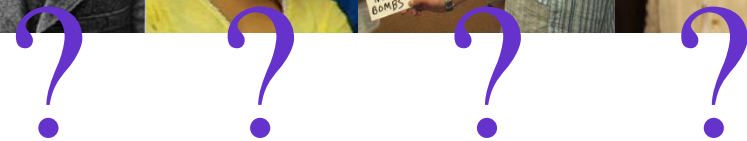
