What is it?

The camp is run by Pax Christi, the International Catholic Movement for Peace. This year's camp will look at the theme of migration. Activities will include:

- Workshops and discussions on asylum seekers and refugees, migration, people trafficking, conflict, inter-faith work.

The camp is for young adults aged 18-30ish.

Where will I stay?

You will be staying at the Pax Christi Peace House in the hills near Florence, Italy. The accommodation will be in dormitory style rooms.

How much does it cost?

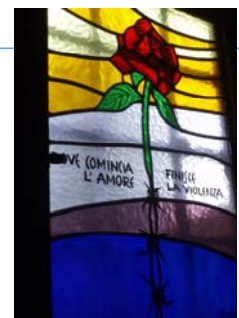
€120 - this includes accommodation, food and all activities, but not travel to and from the Peace House.
